

Course Title: Advanced Placement Art History 0100300(Y)

Prerequisite: Teacher recommendation. Seniors only. Currently enrolled in AP English, Dual Enrollment, English, or AICE English.

*Note – AP/AICE English or AP/AICE History experience is strongly recommended due to fast-paced reading and intense writing. This should not be your first experience in an AP course. AP Art History is designed to provide an introductory college course in art history. In this course, students examine major forms of artistic expression from the ancient world to the present and from a variety of different cultures. They learn to look at and analyze works of art within their historical context, and to articulate what they see or experience in a meaningful way. Students learn how and why works of art communicate visual meaning. Required Summer Reading: see Mrs. Green in Portable 95 for summer reading packet.
