

Course Title: Advanced Placement Studio Art 2D Design Portfolio* 0109350(Y)

Pre-requisite: Creative Photography 1, Architecture Design, 2D Art Comprehensive, Portfolio, Creative Photography 2, Creative Photography 3 or Portfolio 3 with Instructors Approval

The AP program in 2D Design in Studio Art is intended for highly motivated students who are seriously interested in the study of art. This course is intended to address a broad interpretation of two dimensional design issues: While the AP portfolio requires a minimum of 24 works of art, it can be assumed that, due to the nature of the artistic process, many more than 24 pieces will need to be created throughout the year. Students may use artwork from previous art courses, and work created independently. However, the majority of the work is likely to be completed during the current year. The AP Studio Art: course involves a high level of commitment and energy. Students are expected to work beyond scheduled class time. Studio Art is not a course based on a written examination; Instead students submit portfolios for evaluation at the end of the school year to the College Board and the Advance Placement Program. A.P. Studio Art: students focus on mastering the art of image making through a wide range of experiences, including: drawing techniques, photography, digital imaging, collage making, painting, printmaking, mixed media, assemblage, etc., subject matter and the development of a personal approach to art making. Additional lab fee is required for portfolio preparation. Art fee is \$ 35.
