

Course Title: Advanced Placement Studio Art 3D Design Portfolio* 0109360(Y)

Pre-requisite: Ceramics 1, 2 and 3 with Instructors Approval

The purpose of this college level course is to show, creative investigation of traditional and conceptual issues in 3D design. In this course students will explore our physical world- gravity, weight, movement and balance to determine how it relates to space. The course will include various means of assessment. This course is intended to address a very broad interpretation of sculptural issues in three- dimensional design. Students will participate in individual and group critiques building on written and verbal skills with the teacher and peers. They will to analyze and evaluate their own artwork and those of their classmates. This course enables students to develop mastery in concept developing an idea, composition (using the elements of art and the principles of design for effective organization), and execution (technical skills) of 3 dimensional design. The concept of quality is reinforced throughout the year in critiques and assessments that are based of AP Studio Art 3D Design scoring guidelines. The work must meet the standards of an introductory college course. Additional lab fee is required for portfolio preparation. Art fee is \$35.
