

FLEMING ISLAND HIGH SCHOOL – UNDERCLASSMEN PARKING 2016-2017

ALL freshmen and any vehicle without an appropriate parking permit are forbidden to drive to school. Violation of this may result in removal of the car at the owners' expense. Parking permits are \$20.00. A valid drivers' license and current vehicle registration with proof of valid insurance are required. **Parking permits pulled for disciplinary or attendance reasons must be replaced for \$20.00 before parking privileges may be reinstated.** Parking spaces are limited and registration will close on the dates posted.

SENIORS AND UNDERCLASSMEN may drive automobiles or motorcycles to school when the following conditions are met: **(please initial each item verifying you have read and agreed to the policies)**

- ___ 1. Students must show registration, valid drivers' license and proof of valid insurance to purchase a parking decal.
- ___ 2. **STUDENTS MAY PARK ONLY IN THE UNDERCLASSMEN PARKING AREA. PARKING IN THE TEACHER LOT, TTC LOT OR BUS AREA IS NOT PERMITTED AT ANY TIME. PARKING ON CURBS OR OTHER UNAUTHORIZED AREAS WILL RESULT IN TOWING AND/OR THE LOSS OF DRIVING PRIVILEGES.**
- ___ 3. Students must observe the posted speed limit on campus. Violations of driving laws may result in revocation of parking privileges as well as fines.
- ___ 4. Cars must be locked while in the parking lot.
- ___ 5. Students are not permitted to remain in their cars after arriving at school, and students are not permitted to be in cars at any time during the school day. **Prior authorization is required to return to the parking lot for any reason before the end of the school day.**
- ___ 6. Proper identification will be requested when leaving campus during the school day.
- ___ 7. **Parking permits must be displayed on the front window in the lower left hand corner.**
- ___ 8. Students with excessive tardies to school are subject to revocation of parking privileges at administration's discretion.
- ___ 9. **SCHOOL OFFICIALS MAY CONDUCT A WARRANTLESS SEARCH OF A STUDENT'S VEHICLE OR ANY STORAGE AREA ON SCHOOL PROPERTY IF SUCH OFFICIALS HAVE REASON TO BELIEVE THAT ILLEGAL, PROHIBITED, OR HARMFUL ITEMS MAY BE CONCEALED.**
- ___ 10. **ANY STUDENT IN VIOLATION OF THE ABOVE POLICIES IS SUBJECT TO TOW AT OWNER EXPENSE.**

Parking Permits could also be revoked for the following offenses:

- * *Absenteeism*
- * *Off campus during lunch*
- * *Improper parking*
- * *Vandalism*
- * *Theft*
- * *Speeding/Reckless driving*

Underclassmen must also meet the following academic requirements to obtain parking privileges on campus.

- 1. Students must have a cumulative 2.0 grade point average and at least 12 credits for juniors, 6 for sophomores.
- 2. Students who have a cumulative 3.0 grade point average or higher and required credits receive a good student discounted pass for \$15.00
